JUNIOR POLICY

Policy Statement:

Moorebank Cricket Club is committed to Junior cricket development. The club will support our volunteer coaches and managers who are dedicated to the development of our young players and who adhere to the following guidelines.

Implementation of the Policy:

- 1. All players are to be encouraged and allowed to participate in all positions (bat, bowl, keeper, field).
- 2. Bowling is to be shared and not constantly dominated by just a few.
- 3. All players must be given an opportunity to make a contribution to the side. In the higher grades, if the standard of a person's bowling is such that it is detrimental to the players own enjoyment if he were made to bowl, then that player should be regularly batting in the first half of the batting order. Otherwise, the following guidelines apply:
 - a. All players will have bowled a minimum of 15 overs by the end of the season
 - b. All players will have batted in a minimum of 5 innings by the end of the season
- 4. Batting orders are to be adjusted to allow weaker players the experience of partnering with a stronger player.
- 5. Rotate fielding positions and utilise the 12th and 13th player
 - a. Where there is a squad of 12 players, no player is to be the 12th player on more than 2 occasions throughout the season
 - b. Where there is a squad of 13 players, no player is to be left out of the starting X1 when available on more than 3 occasions
- 6. No favouritism
- 7. All players, officials and parents are to adhere to the Cricket Code of Conduct
- 8. It's not all about winning but about development and having fun. Moorebank Cricket Club will be monitoring this policy throughout the season
